Parent's Day Out (PDO) Preschool– Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9:00 a.m.-2:30 p.m., children ages 12 months-2 years develop a foundation of trust and security as they are placed in nurturing classes with small teacher to child ratios. First Baptist PDO uses the Weekday Early Education (WEE) curriculum. WEE Learn is a Christian based curriculum that provides weekly Bible stories and Bible verses along with developmentally appropriate hands on learning.

Tuesday, Wednesdays and Thursdays, <u>3's</u> through pre-kindergarten children attend developmentally appropriate preschool classes. Enrichment opportunities are provided through Chapel, Spanish and Music classes. The program is designed to help a child develop physical, social/emotional, spiritual and academic skills. (Wednesdays are only offered throughout the calendar school year)

Parents of children enrolled in Parent's Day Out Preschool are responsible for providing a healthy sack lunch for their child. Lunches should not require heating or cooling.

The center is open from 7:15-5:30 Monday-Friday. Child care is available for children six weeks old through pre-kindergarten. In addition to a Christian education, children are also taught all of the skills they will need to be successful in Kindergarten. We also have a summer camp program for children who have completed Kindergarten called Camp Kaleidoscope.

Lunch and Snacks-We provide a midmorning breakfast snack, an afternoon snack, and a hot lunch. Food brought due to special dietary needs should be accompanied by a note from a physician.

Enrollment-First Baptist Preschool Development Center is licensed by the Texas Department of Protective and Regulatory Services. Our classroom enrollment is in compliance with the Texas Minimum Standard Rules for licensed child-care centers. Our teacher/child ratios meet and in most cases are smaller than minimum standards allows. State standards may be periodically updated. Parents will be notified in writing of these policy changes if applicable.



Family Discount— If there is more than one child in a family enrolled, a 10% discount will be applied towards the older child's tuition. If three children are enrolled, the same discount will apply to the oldest two children.

Religious Emphasis— We believe that a child forms his concepts of God from people, things, and experiences that construct his environment. A love for and an appreciation of God, Jesus and the Bible are communicated through appropriate activities for each age. We help each child grow in the knowledge that God made the world and that God loves and cares for him.

Field Trips— Field trips may be planned for children in the older classrooms. Field trip information is sent home approximately 2 days before the trip. Children are transported by bus on field trips.
